

PROPOSAL FOR SUPPORT

1. Summary

Saikripa is a non-profit registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860 in Noida, Uttar Pradesh functioning since 1988 for the welfare of the parentless and underprivileged children.

The budget for the Project Sai Vocational Training Centre, NOIDA for the financial year 2019-20 is estimated around Rs. **947,500.00 (Ten Lakhs Sixty Seven Thousand Five Hundred only)**

2. Introduction

Our main activities are:

- **Balkutir**- Home for parentless and abandoned children.
- **Sai Shiksha Sansthan**- a co-educational, English medium Secondary school with a strength of 450 children in village Wazidpur, NOIDA.
- **Sai Bal Sansar & Sai Vatsalya Vatika** - a free informal education centre for the street and slum children with a strength of around 220 children, having a separate unit for special children. Midday meal is also provided.
- **Sai Vocational Training Centre** – Imparting training in Tailoring, Baking/cooking, Beauty culture, Computer & Spoken English to around 200 youths and women from underprivileged society of NOIDA.

Saikripa's beneficiaries are abandoned, parentless and underprivileged children, youths and women from slums and villages.

Focus Project:

Sai Vocational Training Centre – Started in the year 2010 the training centre is Imparting training to around 200 youth and women of underprivileged society of NOIDA in Tailoring, Baking/cooking, Beauty culture, Computer & Spoken English every year at a very nominal fee between Rs. 300 to Rs. 500 p.m. for different courses. SVTC has benefited around 2000 students out of them most of them got placed according to their abilities.

3. Project Background

Nowadays professional courses are beyond the reach of poor due to the unaffordable cost. As such they are unable to acquire the skills that give them their livelihood. Hence this project Sai Vocational Training Centre makes them small entrepreneurs or secure jobs that sustain them.

This Centre needs financial support for regular running of the project, elaborate expansion in areas like infrastructure, equipment's and raw materials etc.

4. Program Goals & Objectives

Your support will help us to provide basic vocations to the underprivileged youths and women who are not able to sustain themselves due to poverty and lack of opportunity.

The beneficiaries are around 200 students from the underprivileged section of the society in and around sector 12 and sector 22 NOIDA.

At the end of the course the students are able to take up some job or start their small setup at home and earn their livelihood.

5. Methodology and Timeline

Student is enrolled in a suitable course are imparted training according to the duration of the course. After completion of the course the student gets suitable entry level for jobs or starts doing some small business in their own homes.

6. Beneficiaries and Impact

Target beneficiaries will be the youth and women of areas nearby sector 12 and 22 NOIDA U.P-201301.

7. Monitoring and Evaluation Plan

The support will be monitored and evaluated at different levels such as program officer, executive director and board members. Reporting is carried out periodically like quarterly, half yearly and annually. Evaluation is assessed by the results obtained on completion of course by the concerned instructors of the course.

8. Any other support for the project

We hope the existing sources of support like general donations from the public.

9. Sustainability Plan

The fees collected from the students are highly subsidised to enable the underprivileged students to get advantage of learning this courses at an affordable cost. The funds received from the fees is hardly sufficient to meet the expenses needed to run this project. Hence, funds from other sources are needed to run the project without interruption.
